## Hop On, Hop Off Shuttle


Our Hop On, Hop Off Shuttle is operating again. The last days available for 2020 are Wednesday, November 28th and Wednesday, November 18th. The shuttle serves members in the zip code areas of: 21076, 21077, and 21144.

The following safety precautions are being followed so that riders feel safe and secure:

- All staff including the driver wears a mask at all times
- All passengers wear masks at all times
- Hand sanitizer is carried on the buses and is available for any passengers who wants it.
- Buses are thoroughly cleaned (after every use) and maintained based on MDOT/MTA guidance.
- Passengers are seated six feet apart. Since the ridership is small it is easy to socially distance on the vehicle.
