PIC Ride Partners Factoids!

Plan Ahead! PIC members can schedule one ride per week with at least 7 calendar days notice. Need a Monday ride? Call the Monday before!

Ride Matching Magic! Our team works hard to match your ride requests, but availability depends on volunteer drivers. We'll give you a heads-up at least 24 hours in advance if we can't secure a ride. Always have a Plan B!

Tolls & Parking? That's on You! Members are responsible for any parking or toll fees during their ride.

Two-Stop Rule! Need to run errands? You can request up to two stops per ride. More stops? Consider spreading them out over multiple weeks!

PIC Mobility, Moving Older Adults in the Right Direction

For over 31 years, PIC has helped older adults stay in their homes and connected to their community, with transportation as one of its signature services. Partners In Care's Mobility Bus is moving Older Adults in the right direction, operating a fleet of five lift-equipped Mobility buses and a minivan, providing door-to-door service for individuals, couples, and groups in Anne Arundel County. The Mobility Bus is a safe, flexible, and affordable option that accommodates wheelchairs, power chairs, and other mobility devices. It's available on-demand, seven days a week (excluding major holidays), and you don't need to be a PIC member to ride.



Several years ago, Anne Arundel County's Department of Aging and Disabilities partnered with PIC to offer group trips for senior centers. Popular destinations include restaurants, museums, shopping centers, and Amish markets. Riders frequently praise the clean, comfortable buses and professional, friendly drivers. One rider shared, "I don't worry about directions because I know the driver has everything under control. I sit back, laugh, and talk with my friends."

PIC provides the same high-quality service to all older adults aged 50+ in Anne Arundel County. PIC members enjoy waived application fees, while non-members pay a one-time \$25 fee. Rates are \$35 per hour for trips up to 20 miles.

About 4% of Medicare beneficiaries over 65—around 1.6 million people—are considered homebound, which can lead to isolation, depression, and a lower quality of life. 
